



MMM Team Awarded \$100 Million Contract to Provide PM Services for TTC Spadina Subway Extension

Major subway expansion will add six stations, including two in York Region

March 28, 2008 -- MMM is a member of the joint venture consortium, Spadina Link Project Managers, that has been awarded the seven-year, \$100 million project management services contract for the Spadina Line Extension by the Toronto Transit Commission. The other two members of the team are Hatch Mott MacDonald and Delcan.

The \$2.1 billion Spadina Line Extension project is a TTC infrastructure initiative sponsored by three levels of government – the Government of Canada, the Province of Ontario and the City of Toronto/York Region. The extension will expand the TTC subway network outside the City of Toronto for the first time. It will extend the Spadina Subway line by 8.6 km and add six stations, of which 2.4 km and two stations will be entirely in the Regional Municipality of York. One station straddles the Region of York/City of Toronto boundary; another will serve York University, while the terminus will be at Vaughan Centre.

The project is expected to begin in April 2008 with an anticipated completion in seven to eight years. Up to 35 MMM staff will eventually be dedicated to the project, working out of TTC's Spadina Subway Extension project office.
