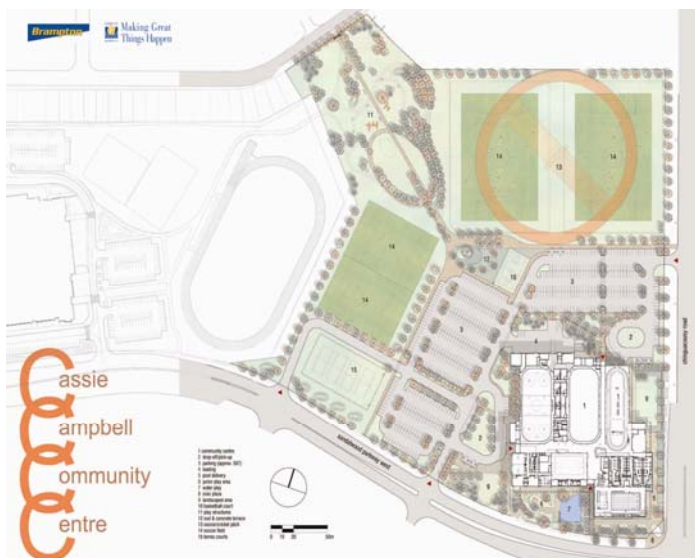


BRAMPTON COMMUNITY CENTRE PROJECT WINS THREE AWARDS

**MMM responsible for civil and stormwater
management of this project**



October 20, 2009 -- MMM was responsible for the civil and stormwater management of the Cassie Campbell Community Centre, which recently won three Brampton Urban Design Awards.

This 165,000 ft² multi-purpose community centre, which was completed in 2008, was given the Award of Excellence, Best Overall Public Building and People's Choice Award in an evening ceremony presented by the City of Brampton on September 30th.

It is the largest and most modern facility in Brampton located on a 27-acre lot at the northwest corner of Chinguacousy Road and Sandalwood Parkway. It is named after Brampton's former resident Cassie Campbell who was Captain of Canada's National Women's Hockey Team and a three-time Olympian.

The facility includes a citywide fitness centre, figure skating rink, hockey rink, a pool and an extensive outdoor program with tennis courts, basketball courts, splash pads, three outdoor soccer fields, with two fields converting to a cricket pitch, and a neighbourhood park. In addition to these features, there will be an indoor running track, a community police centre, community meeting rooms and the City's first community gymnasium.
