



MMM TEAM TO UNDERTAKE QUEBEC CITY – WINDSOR HIGH SPEED RAIL EA

MMM Group Limited in partnership with KPMG, Dessau, WSA and DBI has been retained by the Ministère des Transports du Québec in cooperation with the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario and Transport Canada to re-evaluate the previous feasibility study of High Speed Rail (HSR) to take into account new conditions, such as:

- Strong economic growth resulting in increased development along the Corridor;
- Increased highway, railway and airport congestion along the corridor;
- Increased implementation of HSR technology and service performance of HSR operations;
- Increased interest in environmentally sustainable transportation methods by all three governments;

The ability of such operations to cover some or all of their capital and operating costs are of interest to the three governments, as are the factors that influence financial viability and long-term sustainability.

Responsibilities of MMM's team will include:

- Study review and updating recommendations;
- Review of representative routing options;
- Updating of construction and operations costs;
- Analysis of environmental and social impacts; and
- Impacts of HSR on corridor transportation system.
